

Playground FAQ

1. Does the turf have a fire Rating/astma standards? **Yes, on the pill burn test that we have.**
2. Does the turf get hot in the sun and will it burn children playing on it? **It's about 20 degrees warmer than natural grass. It's really only an issue if the temperatures are in excess of 100 degrees. Kids will usually play in the shade when it gets that hot, or water can be used to cool down the surface.**
3. What are the fall rating standards for this product? Is their a fall rating standard? **The turf and rubber will give you about 2.5 feet fall height. The Playfall tiles give you the most fall height protection. You can get the fall ratings for the Playfall tiles at www.northwestrubber.com**
4. What is the color fad potential for this product? **It will only fade about 2 pantones colors every 10 years, which is hardly noticeable. UV additives are mixed into the yarn resins so it does an excellent job of keeping the color.**
5. What is the life expectancy for this product in a playground setting? **Really depends on how much use it gets, but I would say anywhere from 8 to 20 years.**
6. If areas need replacement or "patched" is this hard to do? Do we need a professional for this type of work? **No, it's easy to patch, you can do yourself. You'll probably have scraps left over from your installation, just keep those.**
