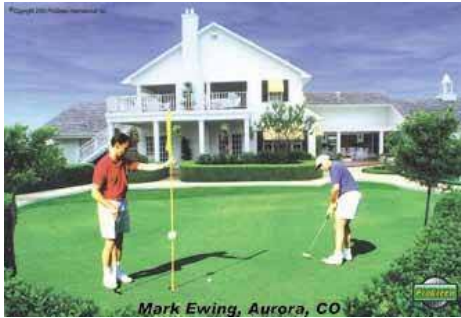

"Because our granule's 'round' shape prevents bonding, the green's surface avoids crusting which is what 'angular' sand naturally tends to do. Crusting - or hardening - of the surface requires periodic brushing or sweeping.



Synthetic putting greens can be designed for any size, shape or contour in both residential and commercial settings. Other than occasionally blowing leaves or debris off the green, there is no maintenance and no need to cover the surface. ProGreen turf employs a resilient UV resistant polypropylene fiber that can withstand the effects of rain, ice, and intense sun and all ProGreen turf comes with a limited 8-year warranty.
